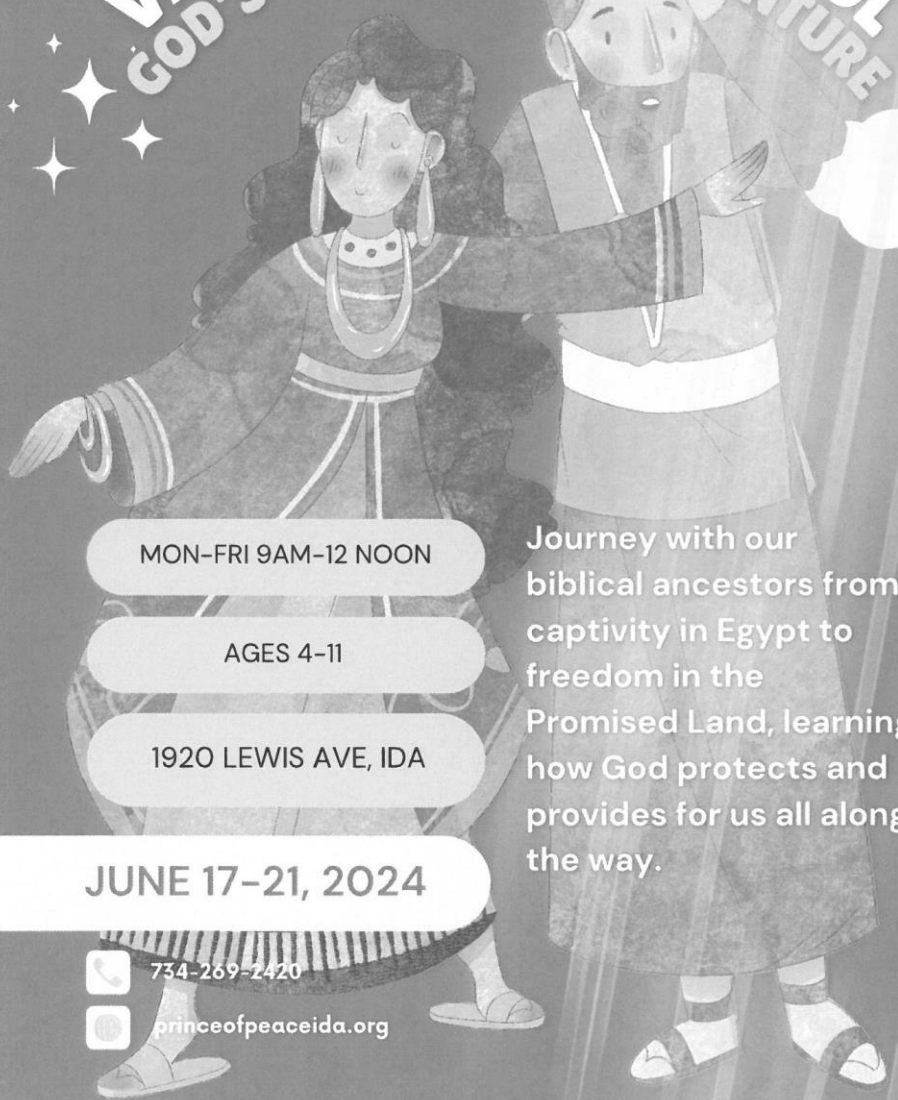
The pews will be removed from the Sanctuary next Sunday for the flooring project. Help, please!


